

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

Left hand side (as you sit on the motorcycle)

- Remove the original LHS & RHS pillion footrest brackets.
- Offer the two blanking plates (**Items 1 & 2**) into position and secure using the M8 bolts (I**tem 3**) as shown in <u>COMPONENT PARTS DIAGRAM</u> and the **Picture on page 1**.
- Tighten all 4 bolts.


