

M4 BOLT = 8Nm

M5 BOLT = 12Nm

M6 BOLT = 15Nm


M8 BOLT = 20Nm

M12 BOLT = 40Nm







FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

- Place one of the M3 washers (item 3) onto each of the two M3 bolts (item 2) and place through the holes in the downpipe grille (item 1) as shown in picture 1 (please note you may have to carefully move the mesh strands slightly with a small screwdriver to allow the bolts to pass through the component).
- Place the spring clips (item 4) onto the exposed end of both bolts and secure in position using the remaining M3 washers (item 3) and M3 self-locking nut (item 5) (do not fully tighten at this stage) as shown in picture 2.
- To fit the radiator guard to the bike, first cut the self-adhesive foam strip provided (**item 6**) into 10mm wide pieces and stick them to the back of the downpipe grille frame (**item 1**), so that they will sit between the down pipe grille and the radiator as shown in **picture 3**.
- Remove the two bolts arrowed in **pictures 4 and 5**.
- Offer the downpipe grille into position (between the mounting brackets and the panels) pushing the two spring clips onto the downpipes and re-use original bolts to secure the downpipe grille in position.
- Fully tighten the two spring clips when satisfied with the positioning.

R&G RETURNS POLICY (NON-FAULTY GOODS)

Returns must be pre-authorised (if not pre-authorised the return will be rejected). Goods may only be returned direct to us if they were purchased direct from us (customer must prove if necessary). Otherwise to be returned to original vendor. Goods must be in re-sellable condition, in the opinion of R&G. All returns are subject to a 25% restocking and handling fee (25% of the gross value exc. P&P – at the prevailing price at time of purchase). The customer must pay any and all carriage charges. No returns of discontinued products, unless within 14 days of purchase. This policy does not affect your statutory rights and does not refer to faulty goods.
