






# **LEFT HAND SIDE**

Please note that in cases where kits are packed with rubber washers holding the components onto the bolt – *the rubber washers should be thrown away!* 

#### TOOLS REQUIRED

• 5mm metric Allen key.

#### Left-hand side (as you sit on bike)

- Fit one of the washers onto the longer cap head bolt.
- Fit the longer cap headed bolt with washer through one of the crash protectors so head sits in counter-bore.
- Place the crash protector on to the longest mounting block (M0422).
- Place special nut on exposed end of bolt so tapered face goes into the mounting block as shown above.
- Tighten bolt until tapered portion of nut just contacts in the recessed face of the mounting block.
- Place this assembly into the left hand side of the front wheel spindle.
- Tighten the bolt so crash protector is held in position firmly (do not over tighten).
- Regularly check to ensure crash protector remains tight.

## Right-hand side (as you sit on bike)

- Fit the remaining washer onto the shorter cap head bolt.
- Fit the shorter cap headed bolt with washer through the remaining crash protector so head sits in counter-bore.
- Place the crash protector on to the shortestest mounting block (M0423).

- Place special nut on exposed end of bolt so tapered face goes into the mounting block as shown above.
- Tighten bolt until tapered portion of nut just contacts in the recessed face of the mounting block.
- Place this assembly into the right hand side of the front wheel spindle.
- Tighten the bolt so crash protector is held in position firmly (do not over tighten).
- Regularly check to ensure crash protector remains tight.







- Placer la protection crash sur le bloc de fixation le plus long (M0422).
- Placez l'écrou spécial sur l'extrémité du boulon de façon à ce que la face conique aille dans le bloc de fixation comme indiqué ci-dessus.
- Serrer le boulon jusqu'à ce que la portion conique de l'écrou entre en contact avec la partie creuse du bloc de fixation.
- Placez l'ensemble du coté gauche du moyeu de la roue avant.
- Serrer le boulon de façon à ce que la protection cash soit maintenue en position (Ne pas bloquer).
- Vérifier le serrage de la protection régulièrement.

• Insérez la rondelle restante dans le boulon le plus court.
