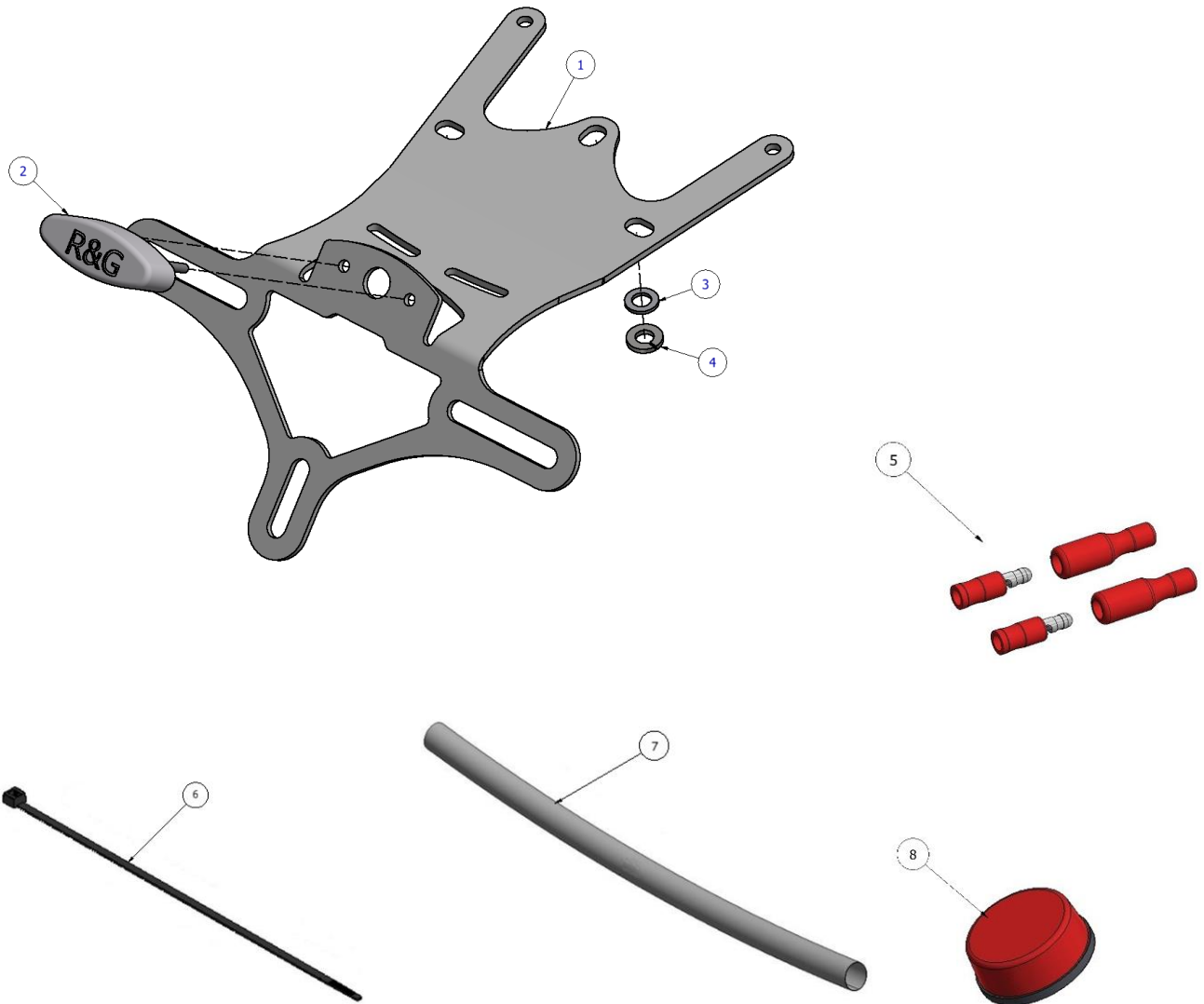

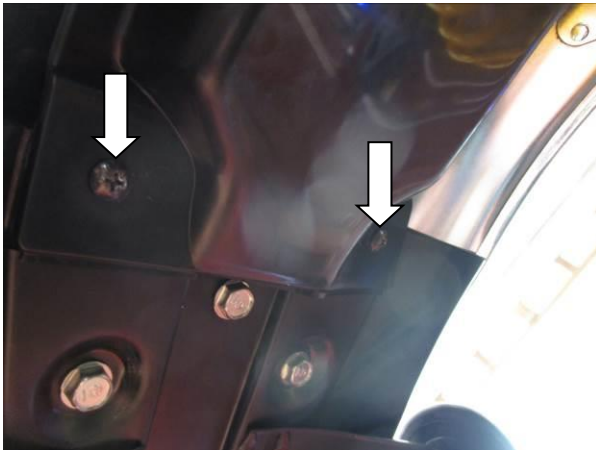

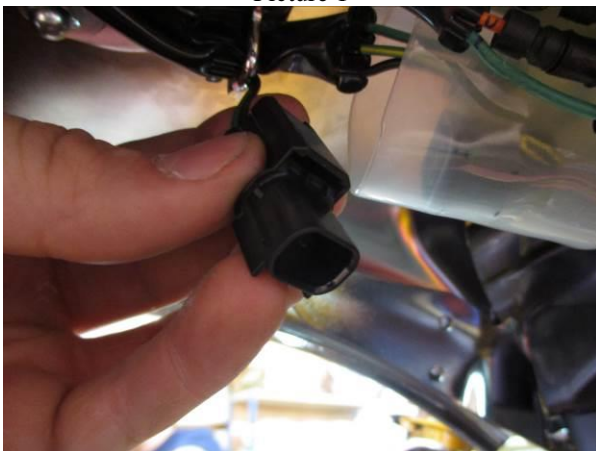
- M4 BOLT = 8Nm

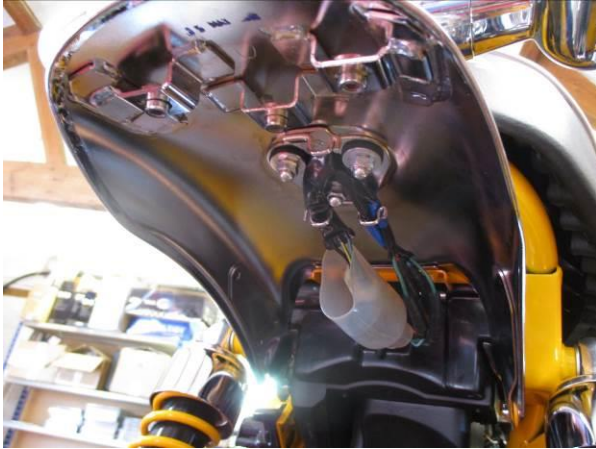

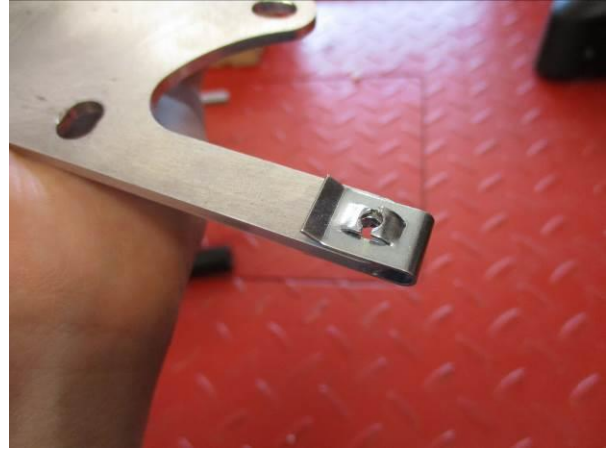

### **FITTING INSTRUCTIONS**

- Remove the two screws under the rear fender, shown in Picture 1.
- Remove the two plastic push rivets, to release the plastic cover (Picture 2).
- Disconnect the licence plate illuminator connector (Picture 3).
- While supporting the plastic fender, undo the three bolts shown in Picture 4 and remove the fender from the bike (Picture 5).
- Remove the two Panel U Clips from the plastic fender and fit them to the two tabs on the tail tidy (Picture 6).
- Fit the licence plate illuminator assembly to the tail tidy using the bolts, washers and nuts provided, please note you will have to fit the light shroud and use a small amount of adhesive to hold it in position.
- To connect the wiring to the licence plate illuminator, the wiring needs to be “cut & shut”. To do this, cut the connector and at least 50mm of wiring off the original licence plate illuminator and fit the bullet connectors that are supplied with the LA0002 to the exposed end of both wires. Connect these to the LA0002 bullet connectors and then re-connect the connector block to the black connector on the OEM loom (if illumination fails, reverse the bullet connectors).
- Fit the tail tidy to the bike (Picture 7), using the three original bolts, and washers (ITEM 3 and ITEM 4).
- Re-fit the plastic cover using the plastic pop-rivets, and two screws.
- Refit the licence plate (it may require drilling).
- Please check the operation of all lights before riding the motorcycle.

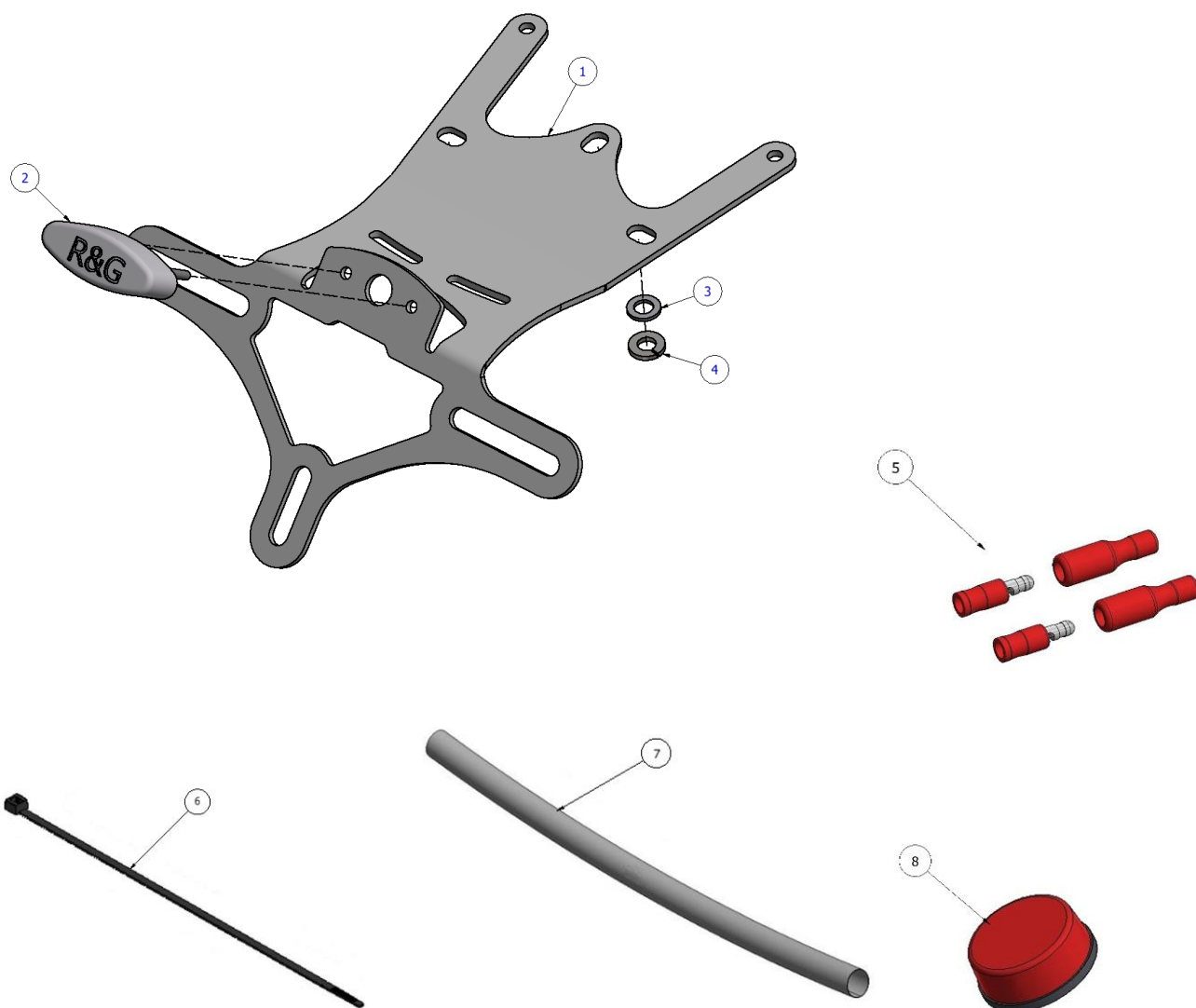

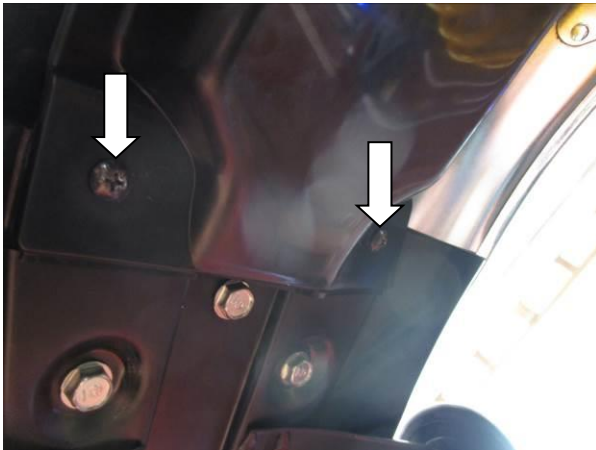

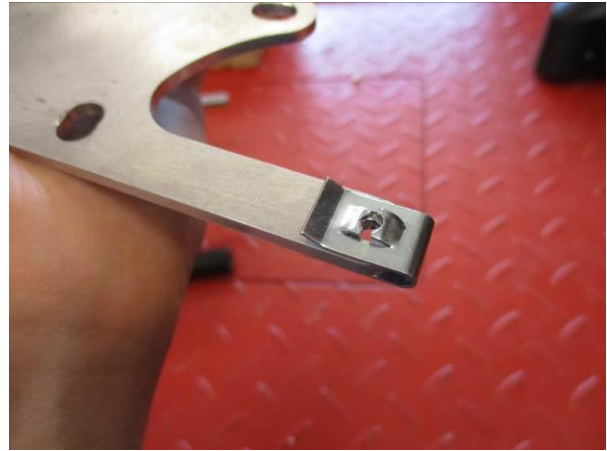

### **NOTICE DE MONTAGE**

- Enlever les 2 vis sous le garde-boue arrière, voir photo 1.
- Enlever les 2 rivets, pour libérer le cache plastique (photo 2).
- Déconnecter le connecteur de feu de plaque (photo 3).
- Tout en supportant le garde-boue, enlever les 3 boulons indiqués sur la photo 4 puis enlever le garde-boue de la moto (photo 5).
- Enlever les 2 clips U de carénage du garde-boue puis montez les sur les 2 onglets du support de plaque (photo 6).
- Monter l'assemblage de feu de plaque en utilisant les boulons, rondelles et écrous fournis, notez que vous devrez monter le linceul de feu en utilisant un peu d'adhésif pour fixer la position.
- Pour connecter le fil au feu de plaque, le fil devra être "coupé et fermé". Pour cela, couper le connecteur à minimum 50mm du feu de plaque puis monter les connecteurs fournis avec le LA0002 sur l'extrémité des 2 fils.
- Connectez-les aux connecteurs LA0002 puis reconnectez le bloc de connecteur au connecteur noir sur le faisceau d'origine (Si l'éclairage échoue, tournez les connecteurs).
- Monter le support de plaque sur la moto (photo 7), en utilisant les 3 boulons d'origine, et rondelles (article 3 et article 4).
- Remonter le cache plastique en utilisant les rivets plastique, et 2 vis.
- Remonter la plaque d'immatriculation (peut nécessiter un perçage).
- Tester l'ensemble des feux avant de prendre la route.

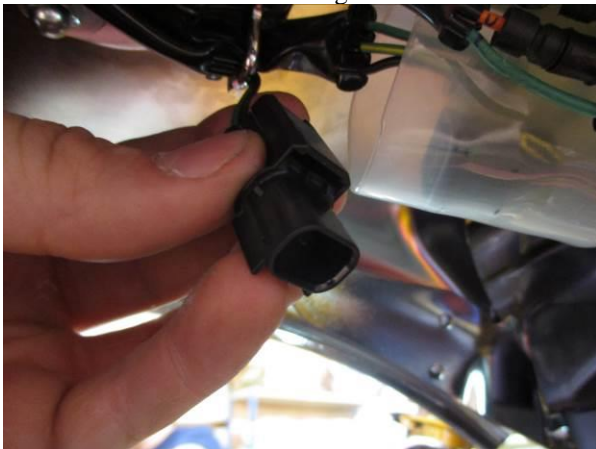

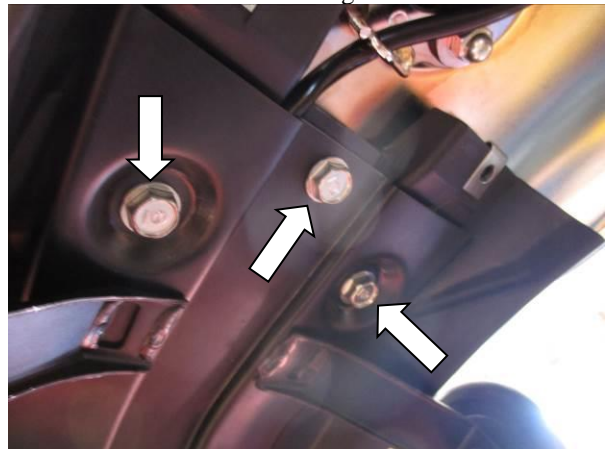

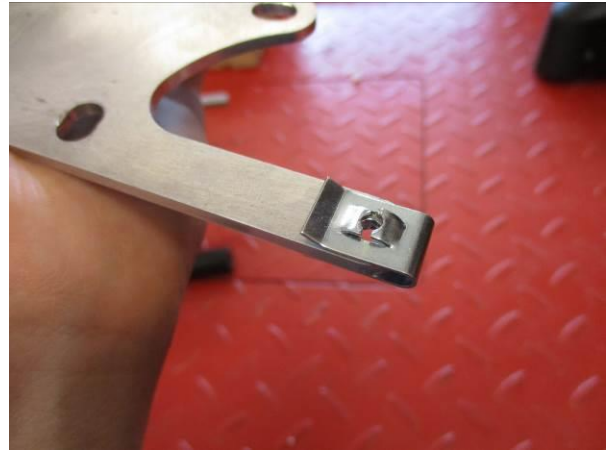

### **MONTAGEANLEITUNG**

- Entfernen Sie die zwei Schrauben unter dem hinteren Schutzblech – siehe Abbildung 1.
- Entfernen Sie die zwei Plastiknieten, um die Plastikabdeckung zu lösen (Abbildung 2).
- Trennen Sie den Steckverbinder für die Kennzeichenbeleuchtung (Abbildung 3).
- Während Sie das Kunststoff-Schutzblech stützen, lösen Sie die drei Schrauben, die in Abbildung 4 abgebildet sind und entfernen Sie das Schutzblech vom Motorrad (Abbildung 5).
- Entfernen Sie die zwei U-Clips vom Kunststoff-Schutzblech und montieren Sie sie an den zwei Laschen am Kennzeichenhalter (Abbildung 6).
- Die Kennzeichenbeleuchtung-Einheit am Kennzeichenhalter mit den Schrauben, Muttern und Unterlegscheiben vom Kit befestigen. Hinweis: etwas Sekundenkleber wird benötigt, um die Lichtabdeckung in Position zu befestigen.
- Um die Kabel mit der Kennzeichenbeleuchtung verbinden zu können, muss die original Verkabelung für die Kennzeichenbeleuchtung abgetrennt und abisoliert werden. Den original Steckverbinder mit mindestens 50 mm Kabel abschneiden und die Kabelverbinder, die mit der LA0002 Kennzeichenbeleuchtung mitgeliefert werden, an den offenen Enden der zwei Kabel anbringen. Verbinden Sie sie mit der LA0002 Kennzeichenbeleuchtung, dann verbinden Sie die Anschlussleiste mit dem schwarzen Verbinder vom original Kabelbaum (falls die Beleuchtung nicht funktionieren sollte, tauschen Sie die Kabel untereinander).
- Montieren Sie den Kennzeichenhalter am Motorrad (Abbildung 7) mit den drei original Schrauben und Unterlegscheiben (Artikel 3 und 4).

- Montieren Sie das amtliche Kennzeichen (Bohrungen im Kennzeichen evtl. notwendig).
- Überprüfen Sie die Funktion der Beleuchtung (Blinker und Kennzeichenhalterbeleuchtung) nochmal vor Gebrauch des Fahrzeuges.
