



FITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR PKS0151SI KICKSTAND SHOE



Please note that the way the kit is packed does not necessarily represent the way of mounting to the bike.

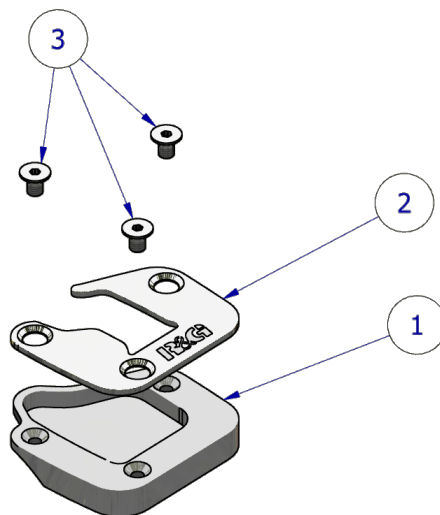
THE PARTS SHOWN MAY BE REPRESENTATIVE ONLY (FOR CLARITY OF INSTRUCTIONS ONLY)
Please note that in cases where kits are packed with rubber washers holding the components onto the bolt – *the rubber washers should be thrown away!*

TOOLS REQUIRED

- 3mm A/F Allen key.
- Loctite Blue 242

LEGEND

- ITEM 1 = MOUNTING PLATE
- ITEM 2 = CLAMPING PLATE
- ITEM 3 = M5 COUNTERSUNK BOLTS
- ITEM 4 = SELF ADHESIVE FOAM



FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

- Take the aluminium mounting plate (ITEM 1) and fit to the base of the side stand from underneath.
- Carefully pass the clamping plate (ITEM 2) around the side stand leg.
- Sandwich the two plates together around the side stand leg, with the countersinks facing upwards on the clamping plate.
- Apply a small amount (one drop) of Loctite Blue 242 to the end of the threaded area of each screw.
- Fit the three M5 bolts (ITEM 3) clamping the two plates together and securely mounting onto the side stand foot.
- Tighten all bolts evenly and check to ensure the side stand pad clears the chain when in the raised position.
- If fitting to older stands that have been worn the padding strip should be placed in the base plate to ensure a tighter fit.

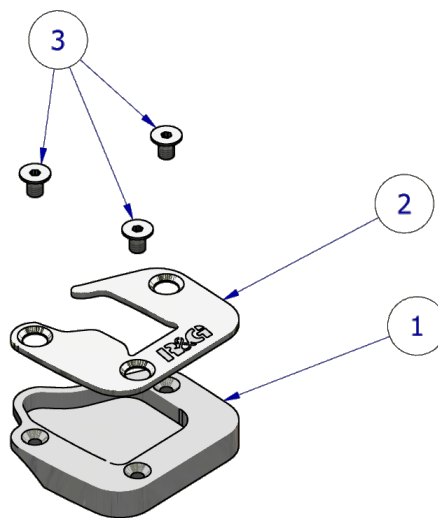
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**OUTILS REQUIS**

- Clé Allen 3mm.
- Loctite Blue 242

LÉGENDE

- ARTICLE 1 = PLAQUE DE MONTAGE
- ARTICLE 2 = PLAQUE DE SERRAGE
- ARTICLE 3 = M5 BOULONS
- ARTICLE 4 = MOUSSE AUTOCOLLANTE

**NOTICE DE MONTAGE**

- Prenez la plaque de montage en aluminium (ARTICLE 1) et fixez-la à la base de la béquille latérale par le dessous.
- Passer avec précaution la plaque de serrage (ARTICLE 2) autour du pied de béquille latérale.
- Enserrez les deux plaques ensemble autour du pied de la béquille latérale, avec les fraises vers le haut sur la plaque de serrage.
- Appliquez une petite quantité (une goutte) de Loctite Blue 242 à l'extrémité de la zone filetée de chaque vis.
- Monter les trois boulons M5 (ARTICLE 3) en serrant les deux plaques ensemble et en les fixant solidement sur le pied de la béquille latérale.
- Serrez tous les boulons uniformément et vérifiez que le coussinet de la béquille latérale soit espacé de la chaîne lorsqu'il est en position relevée.
- En cas d'installation sur des supports plus anciens qui ont été utilisés, la bande de rembourrage doit être placée dans la plaque de base pour assurer un ajustement plus serré.

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
